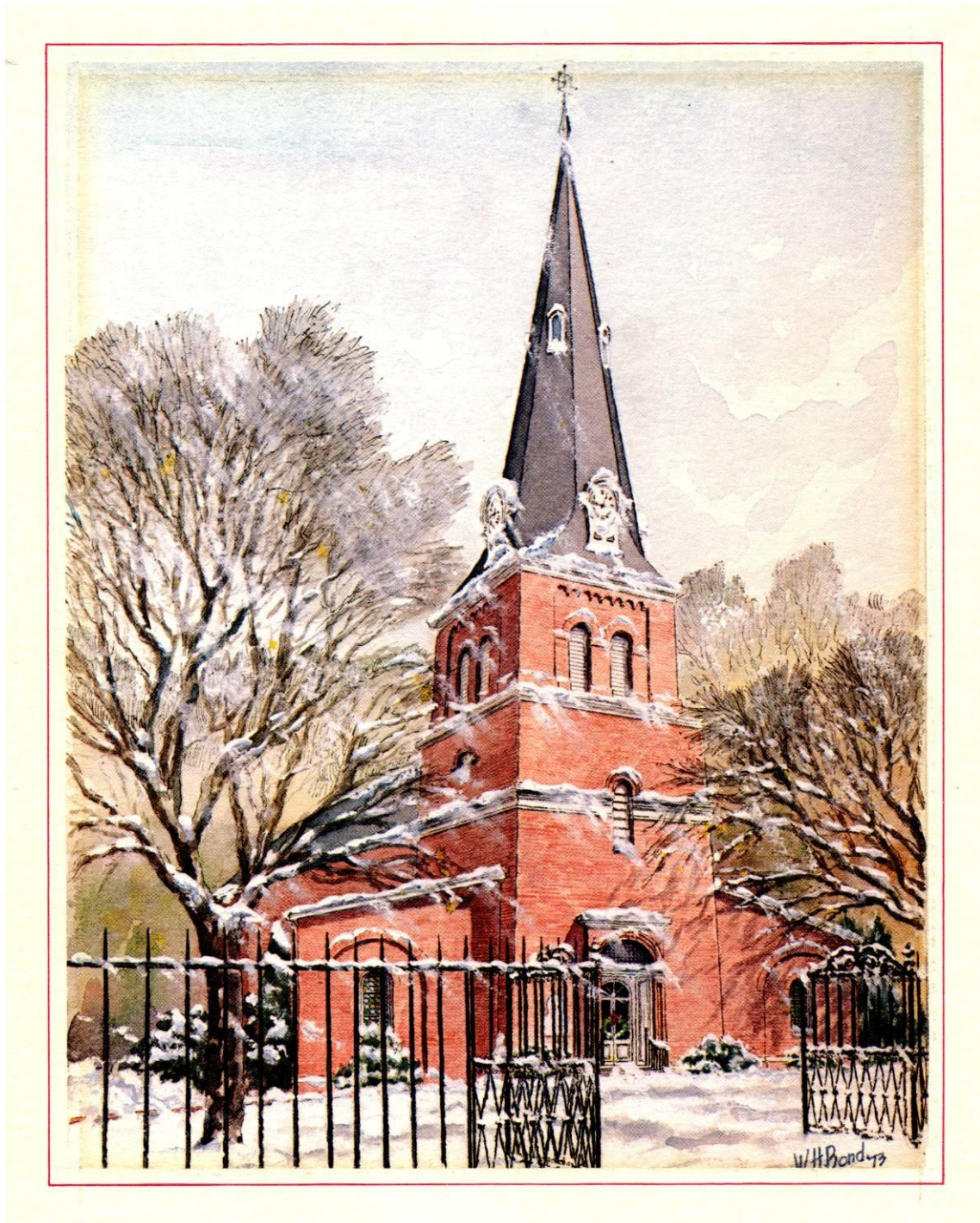

One or Two thing(s) I would like to see happen in St. Anne's Parish:

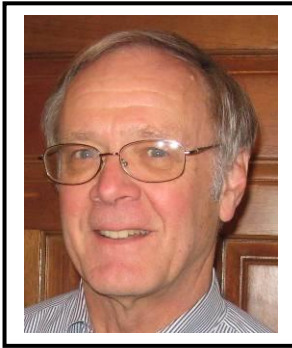

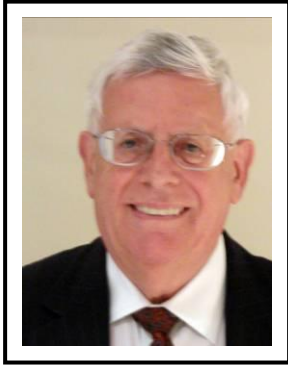

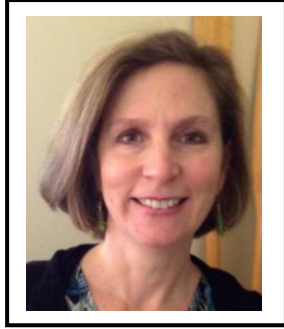
One or Two thing(s) I would like to see happen at St. Anne's:

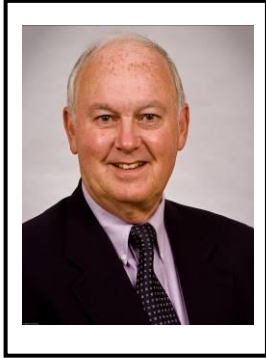

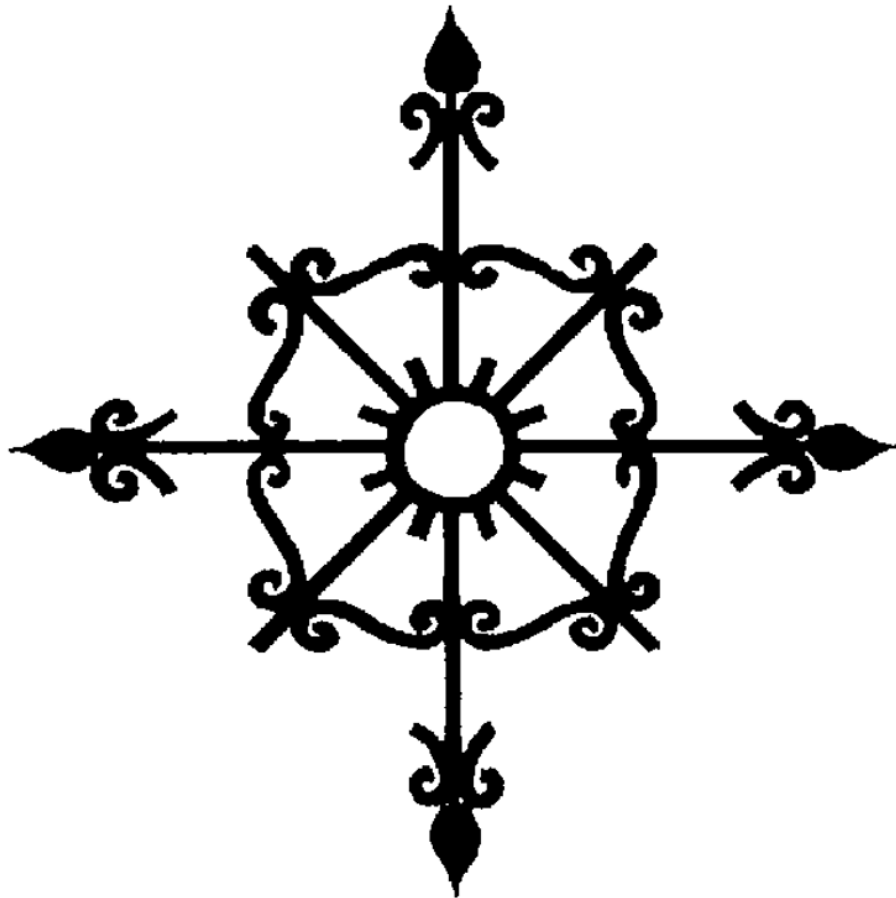
