- Opening Prayer & Devotion
 - o Fr. Dion
- Implementation of Realm (Holly Bentley)
 - o Introduction
 - Went over the Executive Summary (posted on the SharePoint)
 - Rev. Dion Thompson gave an endorsement of how Realm is working for the Bible Challenge
 - o Brief introduction of the Connect app (portal for Realm)
 - o Katie Creeley: Have we received the invites? Holly: Not yet
 - o Howard: Pointed out some issues with the tool, but generally endorsed it
 - o Manoj+: Expressed appreciation to Holly for her work to bring this along
- Outreach Grants Committee
 - o Judy Guy: Provided a handout

- Judy explained the application purpose, acknowledged the committee members, and gave an accounting of the grants that were approved in 2023
- o Total: \$85,792 General fund: \$43,492, LaBrot Trust: \$5K, Virginia Meredith Trust: \$37,300
- Not all grant requests were fully funded (indicated by * in the handout)
- o Letters and checks will be delivered to the applicants on 3/15/23
- The committee will request a report in September to summarize the work done with the funding received
- o Remaining funds (\$1,508) may be disbursed toward the end of the year
- o Bill: Acknowledged the work and management of this ministry
- o Katie B: Is this posted somewhere? A: It is in the Annual Report
- o Lauren: Can we put this on the website (the list of awardees)
- Manoj: We can publish and invite the parish for prayers for the ministries that were awarded
- Susan: Appreciation conveyed for making it an easy process
- o Tom: Kudos to Judy for her organization of the process

• Rector's Report

- o First a survey: Any questions on the report? None
- o Katie C: Appreciated all that Tempest is doing
- o Howard: Asked for embellishment on the Listening Committees. Anticipate that the committee will be formulated and launched in the next few months
- Bill: Reflected the joy of having a fuller church, including the growing population of children. Lauren: The reestablishment of the Sycamore Tree is a key event that helped parents make the decision to come to church
- Manoj+: We are a church that is spread out (Church in the circle, Parish House down the street, accessible parking). Strategic planning must address this for the next several decades.

Junior Warden

- Strategic Planning RFP
 - Simplified version is on the streets
- Facility Committee Notes
 - Bill Wilbur: Discussed future plans for accessibility for our Parishioners
 - Acknowledged that changes to the church will cause angst, but we need some additional changes to integrate our parishioners
 - No suitable place for wheelchairs in the Nave
 - Proposing to remove ½ of two pews, one on each side of the outer aisles (#95 and #40)
 - Katie: Are we removing the full pew and replacing with ½ pew or are we sawing the pew in ½? A: We are sawing them in 2 pieces and removing
 - Adding brass handrails from Nave to the circle (replacing the current rod iron version)

- Al: Appreciated that we are addressing some issues. Can we make improvements to the bathroom? Bill: Most of it is in code, but there are some minor modifications expected
- We have received a parishioner's donation for some of these upgrades
- Considering some other improvements, but they are long-term items
- Manoj+ extended appreciation to Bill and his committee for their hard work
- Vestry Resource Guide Sign-up/Closing Prayer
 - Passed sign-up sheet around for Vestry members to volunteer

• Treasurer's Report

- o PASA Budget
 - Submitted for review budget is consistent with what the Vestry had approved during the general budget discussion
 - Glenn moved to accept the budget, seconded by Al Collins; unanimously approved
 - The strategic plan will also consider how PASA can grow as it is a service to our Annapolis community as well as St. Anne's
- Merrill Lynch transition is almost complete
 - Research turned up documentation supporting the cemetery being part of the parish
 - Strategic Growth Assessment is in process
- Stewardship update
 - We are still short on pledging, but are gaining ground slowly
 - o Howard: How are we doing? It is a mixed result, but mostly encouraging
 - o Non-pledge giving greatly outpaced expectations last year; hopeful for a repeat performance this year
- Registrar Report
